- *Use saws and cutting torches to craft proper pipe sizes.*
- *Turn off steam, water, or gas from pipe section.*
- *Secure pipes to walls and fixtures using brackets, clamps, tools, or welding equipment.*
- *Repair and maintain pipe systems and components.*
